



#### WHAT IS A HOST FAMILY?

## WHO ARE OUR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS?

International students are students who:

- Are 14-18 years old, mature, and responsible
- Are capable of communicating in English
- Are good students who perform well academically
- Bring their own money to spend during their time in America
- Have full medical and liability insurance
- Come with either a J1 or F1 visa
- Have passed the school's screening process including a medical evaluation, English proficiency assessment, teacher recommendations, and academic performance review
- Have completed an orientation meeting
